## **Advisory: Proposed Readoption with Amendments of N.J.A.C. 6A:22, Student Residency**

**Trenton, NJ** – At its Feb. 7, 2024, public meeting, the State Board of Education approved the following rulemaking for publication in the March 18, 2024, *New Jersey Register*:

Readoption with amendments of N.J.A.C. 6A:22, Student Residency, which sets forth rules to establish procedures for school districts to determine students' eligibility to attend school in a particular school district free of charge based on domicile, residency, or "affidavit student" status.
