Notwithstanding any other provisions in this act, of the Federal Fund amounts appropriated for the programs included in the Performance Partnership Grant Agreement with the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the Department of Environmental Protection is authorized to reallocate the appropriations, in accordance with the Grant Agreement and subject to the approval of the Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting.

Notwithstanding the provisions of P.L.1954, c.48 (C.52:34-6 et seq.) or any other law to the contrary, of the amounts appropriated for site remediation, the Department of Environmental Protection may enter into a contract with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to provide the State's statutory matching share for EPA-led Superfund remedial actions pursuant to the State Superfund Contract (SSC).

Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, any grants awarded during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, or during any preceding fiscal year, by the Department of Environmental Protection, or its predecessors, from the proceeds of bonds issued pursuant to P.L.1969, c.127; P.L.1976, c.92; P.L.1980, c.70; P.L.1981, c.261; P.L.1985, c.329; P.L.1989 c.181 or P.L.1992, c.88, or other grants awarded pursuant to other grant programs administered by the department, shall not be considered to be impaired by a structured financing transaction undertaken by a governmental entity which is authorized by section 10 of P.L.1999, c.157 (C.52:31C-10) as amended by section 1 of P.L.2000, c.54, to undertake such transactions, nor shall any State interest created by the award of any such grant be determined to be so impaired by a structured financing transaction undertaken by any local governmental entity pursuant to section 10 of P.L.1999, c.157. Any such grant, and any provisions, covenants and conditions contained in the award thereof, shall not (i) limit, restrict or impair the rights of the local governmental entity to transfer or encumber its facilities or assets for purposes of entering into a structured financing transaction undertaken pursuant to that section, (ii) be violated by the completion of a structured financing transaction undertaken pursuant to that section and (iii) cause the Department of Environmental Protection to rescind or annul any grant, or undertake any other enforcement actions, including the revocation of any permit or license granted, in response to a structured financing transaction undertaken pursuant to that section.

Receipts in excess of the amount anticipated for Air Pollution, Clean Water Enforcement, Land Use, Solid Waste, and Hazardous Waste fines, not to exceed \$1,500,000, are appropriated for the expansion of compliance, enforcement and permitting efforts in the department, subject to the approval of the Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting.

Receipts in excess of those anticipated for the Stormwater Management Program are appropriated to the Department of Environmental Protection for expansion of the Stormwater Management Program to meet new federal mandates relating to the regulation of municipal stormwater management, subject to the approval of the Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting.

Notwithstanding the provisions of P.L. 1954, c.48 (c.52:34-6 et seq.) or any law to the contrary, of the amounts appropriated for water resource evaluation studies and monitoring, the Department of Environmental Protection may enter into contracts with the United States Geological Survey to provide the State's match to joint funding agreements for water resource evaluation studies and monitoring analyses.

Of the amount hereinabove appropriated for the Hazardous Substance Discharge Remediation Loans and Grants-Constitutional Dedication account, an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000 shall be allocated for costs associated with the State Underground Storage Tank Inspection Program, pursuant to the amendments effective December 4, 2003 to Article VIII, Section II, paragraph 6 of the State Constitution. The unexpended balance at the end of the preceding fiscal year in the Underground Storage Tank Inspection Program-Consitutional Dedication account is appropriated, subject to the approval of the Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting.
