Sausage served does not have a CN label or a Product Formulation Statement (PFS) therefore, the contribution toward the meat/meat alternate component cannot be determined. Recipes for deli sandwiches must be revised as it cannot be determined how much M/MA each sandwich contains. Ensure that products used contribute to 2 oz. M/MA each day so that weekly M/MA requirements are met. In addition, production records are not being completed by individual responsible for meal distribution. Staff who receives the meals upon delivery must take and record temperatures of food and milk, record portions leftover, and reimbursable columns on production records, and sign them. These records must be kept for 3 years.


Although production records for review period indicate vegetables are given with all meals, it was evident on day of review that only students who select the hot lunch option receive vegetables with their meal. Vegetables must be available on all service lines and/or with all meals.

At lunch, portion sizes planned for each component must meet both daily and weekly minimum requirements for each appropriate grade group. When planning menus, refer to the Lunch Meal Pattern Charts, available on the Department of Agricultures Form web site for specific component and minimum quantity requirements.
