### Breakfast<sup>\*</sup>

58 meals are sent to the special education classrooms/trailers daily. There is no point of service (POS) count taken for these meals, which is a systemic error. The point in the food service operation is where a determination can accurately be made that a reimbursable free, reduced price or paid lunch has been served to an eligible child. Since meals are sent to the classrooms/trailers, the POS would have to take place once the eligible student receives the reimbursable meal. As stated, this is an systemic error and must be corrected.
