

For lunch we will continue to coded tickets with Apple=A(free), Banana =B(reduced), and Cherry=C(cash). Rosters are updated monthly and given to each teacher to distribute coded tickets. At the end of lunch the designated lunch staff (Mrs. Erin Nero, Mr. Brian Bollinger, and Mrs. Jill Bond) will collect tickets and count the meals served by category and grade. The lunch files will be updated daily to reflect the correct number of meals counted using the Edit Check list. All three schools will use the coded rosters. Students will enter in a line, state their name and the designated staff will check off the students names. The student will then continue on to receive their meal.
