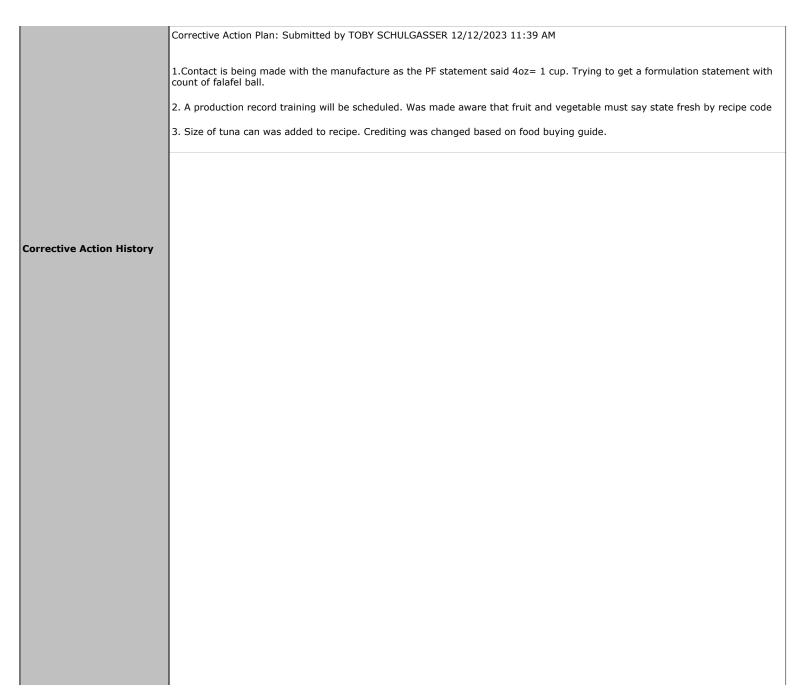

At lunch, production records must be complete including all required fields and document that both daily and weekly minimum quantities for each component are offered for the review week. Other supporting documentation (including but not limited to the USDA Food Buying Guide, food labels, CN labels, manufacturers product formulation statements, standardized recipes, etc.) must be used to determine the creditable amount each menu item contributes to the meal pattern to assure that required minimum quantities are offered. Explain in detail, how the finding will be corrected and the measures taken to ensure that it will not reoccur in the future.

#### Errors:

- 1.) Insufficient quantity of legume vegetable subgroup was offered for the review week. On Thursday Oct 26th, falafel was served and credited for the legume vegetable subgroup for the week. Production records indicated 1/2 cup was offered and credited it as 1/2c legume, which is incorrect. The product formulation statement stated 1cup credited as 5/8 cup legume and 1/8cup other vegetable, thus 1/2c would only credit as 1/4c. The 4 day weekly meal pattern for grades 9-12 requires 1/2c legume vegetable subgroup.
- 2.) Documentation errors on the production records for the review week including the following:
- Missing signature
- -Missing recipe #/product name/code for fruit and vegetables on all days; for crackers, yogurt, and string cheese on Tuesday; for tuna on Thursday
- -Missing portion size on Monday for fruits and vegetables; on Tuesday for fruit; on Wednesday for soup and fruit; on Thursday for fruit and vegetables
- 3.) Although sufficient quantity of meat/meat alternate was offered for the day, the tuna recipe had the following errors:
- -It didn't include the size of the tuna can used and the yield of the can.
- -The crediting on the recipe stating that 3oz portion credited as 3oz m/ma, which is incorrect.

Please explain in detail, how each of the 3 findings will be corrected and the measures taken to ensure that they will not reoccur in the future. Indicate the <u>DATE</u> of implementation for each finding.
