	All components were offered as part of the reimbursable meal pattern during the review period. However, when completing production records, the SFA must ensure that the following areas are consistent and correctly completed:						

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Corrective Action History	 The correct portion size and crediting information is recorded for each menu item. Items needing correction: Sun Cup Apple Juice is 6 oz and should equal 3/4 cup CN Fruit not 1/2 cup. Salad Bowl (Recipe #825120) should have a portion size of 3/4 cup and not "1 each". 1/8 Red/Orange vegetable subgroup should also be documented as part of the 1/2 cup dark green. Recipe Number 825120 does not have the creditable meal components for the veggie subgroup as noted on the PR. Tyson Popcorn Chicken portion size is 12 pieces instead of 3 ounces. Documenting 12 pieces is easier for the dietary staff to correctly provide the proper serving size for each student. 						
	Omit 2- ounce WGR for Ham and Cheese because WW Sliced Bread is documented on the production record.						
	Revise 4x6 cheese pizza (Nardones) and add 2 oz eq for meat/meat alt and 2 oz WGR with 1/8 red/orange.						
	Green Beans has a portion size of 1/2 cup and not "1 each".						
	*** It is recommended that signage is posted for the students for lunch meal allowing them to take up 2 vegetable servings to meet the 3/4 cup minimum daily requirement. The vegetable portion sizes are 1/2 cup.						
	Breakfast:						
	Cranberry Juice Cocktail contains only 15% fruit juice is not compliant with the USDA meal pattern requirements.						
	If Cream O' Land Juice is offered to the students, the 1/2 cup fruit or 4 oz serving should be documented on the production record. Sun Cup is also used in the district which is a 6 oz serving - providing 3/4 cup serving for fruit.						
	Pop Tart equals a serving size of 1 pouch (3.53 oz) WG Raspberry and Cream Cheese Bar equals 3.4 oz or 1 Bar 2 Blueberry muffins equals 4 oz WGR equivalents
