This meets the daily requirement, however it does not meet the weekly requirement. <br> Lunch: <br> The hamburger bun used for the cowboy burger and the cheeseburgers does not meet the 2 ounce equivalent. It is okay to use for the chicken patty due to the grain on the chicken patty. <br> The dinner roll does meet the 2 ounce equivalent. The recipes for salad says that two rolls are being given, however that is not what the production record reports. <br> The black bean burger is not a child nutrition labeled item and must be eliminated from the menu. Luckily there were none served during the week of review. <br> Recipes are not based on what is happening at the SFA. The chicken nugget, cheeseburger, cowboy burger, grilled cheese, chicken patty and chicken nugget recipes all have bread products that are not being used at the site. <br> Portion issues do not require fiscal on the first offense, however on the next review if the same issues are happening they will be a repeat violation and fiscal action will be assessed. <br> Explain in detail, how the finding will be corrected and the measures taken to ensure that it will not reoccur in the future.
