### Public Notice

Take notice that the New Jersey Department of Agriculture is extending the time for comment to the proposed readoption of N.J.A.C. 2:19 Sale and Distribution of Plants and Plant Material. Because of an unintended delay in publication of Notice of the proposed readoption, the comment period is extended from December 31, 2010 to January 17, 2011.

The readoption is without change. These rules address the shipment of rose plants into and within the State of New Jersey because virus-infected rose plants cause a serious economic loss to both the grower that sells them and the consumer who buys them.
