TAKE NOTICE THAT pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq., the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (Board) has scheduled a hearing to receive comments on the New Jersey Clean Energy Program (NJCEP) Comprehensive Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Resource Analysis (CRA) for Fiscal Years (FY) 2019 – FY22 and related programs and budgets for FY19. The public hearing on the CRA and the program budgets and filings will take place on **May 15, 2018, at the at the Department of Environmental Protection, 401 East State Street, Trenton, NJ - Public Hearing Room at 1:00 p.m.** Presiding by President Joseph L. Fiordaliso. A brief presentation will be held on the CRA and the budgets and filings.

The FY19-22 CRA Straw Proposal will be released in conjunction with a four-year Strategic Plan and will propose a four-year funding level. The Strategic Plan presents an energy efficiency program portfolio that will significantly increase the level of energy savings delivered through New Jersey's Clean Energy Program, improve the environment and reduce utility costs. The proposed CRA funding level and FY19 budget will fully fund the NJCEP programs that help residents, businesses and local governments reduce energy usage, save money and improve the environment.
