BY THE BOARD:

On May 21, 2009, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:2-21 and N.J.A.C. 14:1-5.11 and 5.12, Andover Utility Company, Inc. ("Company" or "Petitioner") a public utility of the State of New Jersey subject to the jurisdiction of the Board of Public Utilities ("Board"), and providing wastewater service to three separate customers, the Andover Nursing Home, the Andover Intermediate Care Center and a Condominium Association comprised of 258 units all located in Andover Township, Sussex County, New Jersey, filed a petition for approval of an increase in rates for wastewater service and other tariff charges amounting to approximately \$366,063 or 98.43% above current revenues. Petitioner does not seek interim rate relief pending final determination on the petition.

This matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law ("OAL") for hearings and on July 1, 2009, the Board issued an Order suspending Andover's proposed rate increase until November 1, 2009. This matter is currently before the OAL and hearings are scheduled to begin in January, 2010.


In light of the fact that this proceeding is still pending before the OAL, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:

- (1) Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:2-21, the proposed revisions be, and are further suspended until March 1, 2010, unless the Board prior to that date makes a determination disposing of the petition;


- (2) Petitioner shall, at least ten (10) days prior to the date set for hearing on the petition by the Office of Administrative Law, file with this Board and with the Office of Administrative Law (33 Washington Street, Newark, N.J. 07102) proof of compliance with the Notice provisions of N.J.S.A. 48:2-32.2 and N.J.A.C. 14:1-5.12 (b) and (c), which Notice shall include a statement that any relief found by the Board to be just and reasonable may be allocated by the Board to any class or classes of customers on any rate or schedule as the Board may determine; and
- (3) Petitioner shall serve copies of this Order upon the Office of Administrative Law, the Division of Rate Counsel (31 Clinton Street, P.O. Box 46005, Newark, NJ 07102), the clerk of the affected municipality, the clerk to the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the affected county, and where appropriate, the executive officer of the affected county within its service area. Service of the petition, notice of hearings and this Order may be made simultaneously. Proof of service of this Order shall be filed with the Board within fifteen (15) days of the date of this Order.




