**BY THE BOARD:**

On June 4, 2009, Shiwen Sun ("Petitioner") filed a petition with the Board requesting a formal hearing related to a billing dispute with Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("Respondent" or "PSE&G") regarding a bill for utility service provided by Respondent.

After the filing of Respondent's answer, the Board transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law ("OAL") for hearing and initial disposition as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 et seq. This matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") J. Howard Solomon.


While this matter was pending at the OAL, the parties engaged in negotiations and entered into and signed a Settlement ("Settlement") that was submitted to the ALJ. By Initial Decision issued on February 2, 2010, and submitted to the Board on February 5, 2010, to which the Settlement was attached and made part thereof, ALJ Solomon found that the Settlement was voluntary,

that its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy and that it satisfied the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1. Pursuant to the terms of the Settlement, in order to resolve this matter which relates to service provided to premises located at 168 Clinton Avenue, Newark, New Jersey, Respondent has agreed to credit the Petitioner's account in the amount of \$15,000.00 with said credit to be forwarded to Petitioner in the form of a check.



2. The settlement fully disposes of all issues in controversy and is consistent with the law.


