BY THE BOARD:

This Order memorializes action taken by the Board of Public Utilities (Board) at its August 15, 2012 Agenda Meeting.

The Board of Public Utilities' Renewable Energy Incentive Program (REIP) offers prescribed financial incentives to New Jersey property owners to encourage the installation of Class I renewable energy technologies. Eligible applicants may also receive rebates for a portion of the cost of installing sustainable biomass at their site.

The Staff of the Office of Clean Energy (OCE) has reviewed the applications under the 2012 REIP guidelines for the monetary rebate requested. The OCE finds that each application is complete and fully conforms to all Board eligibility requirements for a rebate commitment under this program. Honeywell, the Market Manager engaged by the Board to manage the New Jersey Clean Energy Program (NJCEP) C&I renewable efficiency programs, has submitted certifications that the incentives for which Honeywell now seeks approval to commit have been calculated in accordance with the program policies and procedures, and that the listed amounts are the true and accurate estimated incentives for which the applicants are eligible. Further, Applied Energy Group, in its role as the NJCEP Program Coordinator, has conducted a file review of each application and submitted certifications that the incentives for which the Market

Manager now seeks approval to commit have been correctly calculated in accordance with the program policies and procedures and that the listed amounts are true and accurate estimated incentives for which the applicants are eligible, as follows:
