Subject: Lack of Verizon Fios in Hopewell Township, NJ

Dear Board members of the BPU,

This email is in response to the proposed plans of Verizon in regards to Fios internet. As a resident of Hopewell Township, NJ I strongly oppose the Stipulation of Agreement 12020155 that would allow Verizon to stop running Fios to areas that get 4g coverage. I currently have Verizon Wireless service for cell phones and a mifi jetpack for internet. I have a family share plan in which the 3 phones and the mifi jetpack share the data on the plan. The data IS NOT UNLIMITED and can cost upwards of 5 times (maybe more) the amount of unlimited Fios high speed internet. The data plans are also flawed in the fact that depending on the size of the plan the cost of 1gb can vary from \$5.00 to more than \$15.00. That's correct, multiple prices for the same exact 1gb of data. If your plan is set on anything under 20gb you can increase the amount of available data by 2gb each time at the rate of \$10.00. Once you get to the 20gb plan your next option is to increase by 10gb at the rate of \$75.00. If you choose to pay the overage fee then you have to pay \$15.00 per GB. Now if you happen to do the 10gb increase and don't use the 10gb and use only 4gb then you lose the remaining 6gb and then you actually paid \$18.75 per 1gb. So as you can see this is not a reasonable option to Fios internet. It will end up costing the tax payers way more than they can ever imagine paying. Now being that there data is so expensive and SLOW, there are plenty of things on the internet that you will not be able to do because you will run out of data or it is just to slow. You won't be able to stream videos, let your kid play online games or really use the internet for what's most important and that's for educational purposes. If this plan goes through it will be a major step backwards for the people of areas that are not currently afforded the opportunity to get Fios services. Currently Fios stops about 1500 feet from my house. This is 2014 and if these major companies can't provide the same service to every resident in the state of New Jersey then they should not be allowed to make money in our state.

**REQUEST TO NOT ALLOW VERIZON OUT OF THE (OPPORTUNITY NEW JERSEY)
HARDWIRE CONTRACT**

As a school teacher and small business owner in the Stow Creek and Hopewell N.J. townships, I am writing this letter to request that the NJBPU does not allow Verizon to renege on the contract of providing 100% of New Jersey residents hardwired, broadband service. I have seen firsthand, the difference between hardwired FiOS and the wireless 4G LTE service. To consider the wireless 4G LTE service as a viable option for business and home use when compared to the capabilities of the hardwired FiOS, is absolutely ridiculous.

First of all, as of March, 2014, Verizon's Home Fusion Broadband service boasts average speeds of 5-12 Mbps download and 2-5 Mbps upload. This is a far cry from the 45 Mbps in both directions that was supposed to be completed by 2010. As an educator and a small business owner, I often require the transfer of large files between email accounts and computers. My productivity often suffers due to the lack of bandwidth that is provided by the 4G LTE speeds. Sending and receiving files related to school and work take tremendous amounts of time out of my day (e.g., downloading videos and activities for my students, files and catalogs for the business).

There is also the price between services to consider. Why would I agree to pay \$120 per month for 30GB of data at the maximum speed of 12 Mbps download and 5 Mbps upload, when I could receive unlimited GBs at a maximum rate of 75 Mbps download and 35 Mbps upload for \$69.99 per month? The answer is, I wouldn't. And according to Verizon's previous commitment to the state of New Jersey, I shouldn't have to.

My wife is also a school teacher who requires the same amount of data usage and bandwidth as I do for lesson plans and curriculum development. If we are both doing work requiring bandwidth and data usage at the same time, it is often in futility. We also have a sixteen month old daughter that we are trying to educationally engage in online interactive lessons designed for toddlers including games, shows, and movies. We attempt to do this through the use of several computers, tablets, smart phones, and Smart TVs. The current speeds of 4G LTE are simply not adequate enough for us to achieve the same standard and level of technology that other students with hardwired internet access are capable of. Are we supposed to tell our daughter that she cannot have access to the countless educational resources available online that require hardwired broadband connectivity simply because the state of New Jersey did not hold Verizon accountable for what they were supposed to accomplish?

I urge the BPU to do all that they can in this matter to prevent Verizon from closing the door on all of the technological and educational benefits as well as productivity that would come from having a hardwired access point directly to my home and office. My career, business, and most importantly, my daughter's education, would greatly benefit from having a hardwired, broadband connection with the upload and download speeds that everyone in the state of New Jersey deserves.

Under the 1993 "Opportunity New Jersey" regulatory agreement, Verizon is obligated to upgrade New Jersey's copper wire network. To fund this expansion, which was supposed to be completed in 2010, Verizon was permitted to collect excess charges from their customers. These charges, which began more than 20 years ago, are still being collected today.

However, Verizon failed to meet its timeframe requirements to New Jersey residents under Opportunity New Jersey. As a result of Verizon's failures, on March 12, 2012, the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities initiated a legal action against Verizon. The Board and Verizon have now entered into a proposed settlement agreement which I believe is inadequate and not in the best interests of myself and other New Jersey consumers who have paid for a service that has not been fully delivered.

I have been reading with interest the changes to Verizon's "Opportunity NJ" plan. I would like to submit this statement with respect to my residence (and neighborhood) within the township of Wyckoff.

It is clear that Verizon has stopped the installation of "FIOS" service within the township and has left pockets of neighborhoods in Wyckoff without the option of FIOS service. Therefore, Verizon has left parts of the township with only inferior alternatives to Cablevision's Optimum service which is the only high speed internet service available.

I find this unequal deployment of Verizon FIOS a violation of their "Opportunity NJ" plan and the solution of leaving their "DSL" service as the only option of an alternate service discriminatory and not equal to cabled options. Their deployment of FIOS within Wyckoff was deployed inconsistently and wherever access was "easy". There are over 100 residences within my community of Barrister Farms, accessible easily from the main road, yet FIOS was not deployed in this area. This community was developed roughly 12 years ago and was not completed until 9 years ago.
