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NOTE: In accordance with N.J.A.C. 19:51-1.14(b)1, persons may request in writing that the Commission waive their obligation to qualify as part of a casino service industry license issuance or renewal, in part, that:

“If the person is required to qualify as an officer, the person shall be required to demonstrate that he or she is not significantly involved in and has no authority over the conduct of business with a casino licensee. Such request shall include, at a minimum, the following:

- i. A description of his or her title, duties and responsibilities with the applicant, licensee or with any affiliate thereof;
- ii. The terms of his or her compensation; and
- iii. A certification by the officer or, if the applicant or licensee is governed by N.J.S.A. 5:12-92c and d, by counsel for the applicant or licensee, stating that the officer is not significantly involved in and has no authority over the conduct of business with any casino licensee or applicant; ...”
