WHEREAS, the Division filed a letter report dated March 9, 2015, recommending that the Commission find Mr. Lambert qualified; and

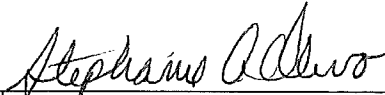


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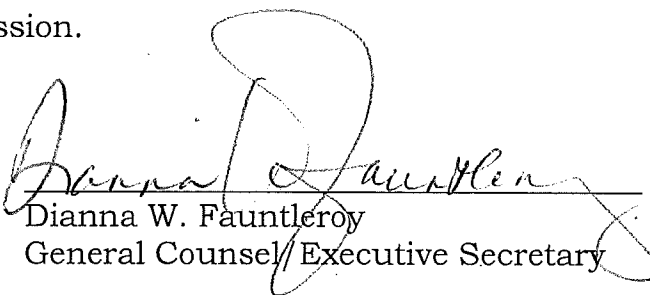
