

Nurse Investigator – Medical Review Analyst

Description:

The Nurse Investigator will conduct comprehensive investigations of New Jersey Medicaid providers and recipients to identify overpayments due to fraudulent, wasteful and abusive practices. Conduct analysis of paid claims, medical record reviews, interviews of providers and recipients and perform field investigations as necessary. Prepare technically sound, accurate and informative investigative, financial, statistical and other reports containing investigative findings, conclusions and recommendations. Conduct settlement negotiations with providers, recipients and attorneys in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. Testify in court at administrative hearings, grand jury and trial.

Responsibilities:

- Conduct analysis of paid claims, medical record reviews
- Conduct interviews of providers and recipients
- Perform field investigations as necessary
- Prepare technically sound, accurate and informative investigative, financial, statistical and other reports
- Conduct settlement negotiations with providers, recipients and attorneys in accordance with applicable laws and regulations
- Testify in court at administrative hearings, grand jury and trial.

Requirements:

- Active Registered Nurse license,
- Bachelor's degree from a four year accredited college or university
- Three (3) years of experience conducting reviews, analysis and investigations.
