<u>IOM Work Authorization Phase III</u> - includes IOM Services for the applicable Construction contract(s) for the Delco Lead Project. The Construction Contract(s) for the Delco Lead Project is described below.

The work required to construct the County Yard Improvements Program includes site work, environmental remediation, railroad infrastructure construction and railroad facility construction. The construction components for the anticipated site work include placement of backfill, retaining walls, culvert extensions, bridge structures, utility relocations, drainage improvements, utility installations, site lighting and associated work elements. 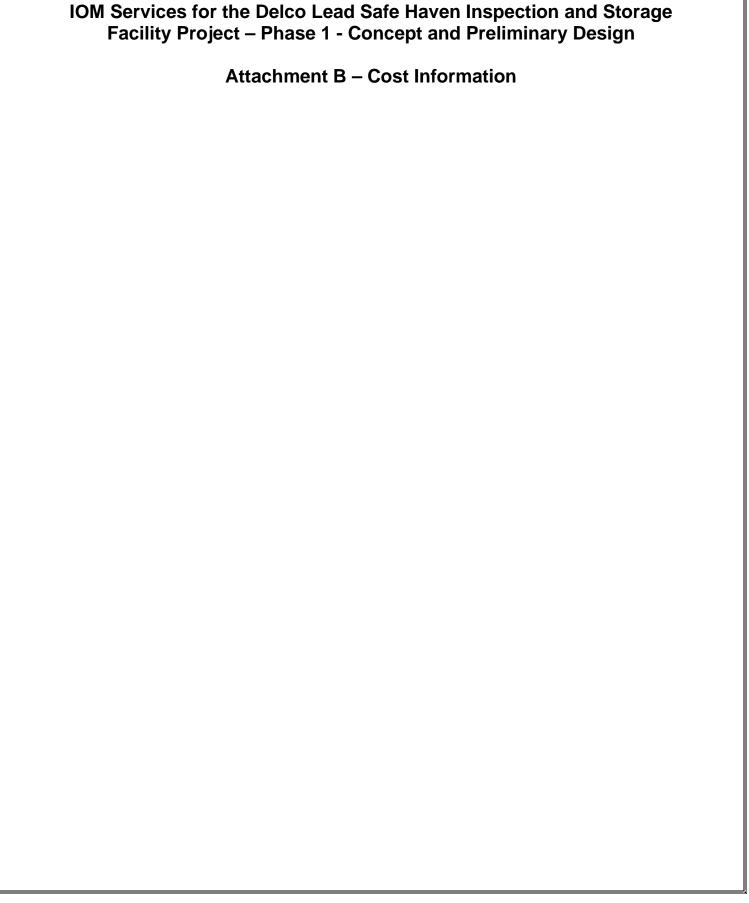
