<b>Overview:</b>
To develop an efficient data-sharing system across key state departments, which will effectively help address emerging health-related issues resulting from Superstorm Sandy. The Department of Health, Human Services, and Children and Families will be the initial and key departments involved in the development and use of the system, but other departments may be brought in as more is learned through the recovery process and broader uses for the shared data are identified. The term “health-related” is used comprehensively here and meant to include any and all data which may provide insight into the physical and mental wellbeing of New Jersey residents.
<b>Federal Department of Origin:</b>
Department of Health and Human Services
<b>Federal Requirements / Restrictions:</b>
Funds to be totally expended by September 30, 2015. Also subject to Integrity Oversight monitoring via Assembly Bill A60 (A-60)(P.L.2013,c.37). Additional State regulations related to Governor Christie's Executive Order 125, as well as all applicable federal and state regulations for Procurement and Grants Management.
<b>Selection Standards:</b>
Services will be provided through a waiver request to expand current data-sharing system via approved vendors. Specifically, funding will be provided via a purchase order with CAI.
<b>Eligibility Standards:</b>
Existing vendors will be utilized to expand current capabilities.
