The Weatherization Program offers energy assistance grants to assist in reducing the residential energy cost of Mercer County's low-income families. There is no charge to participate in the Mercer County Weatherization Program for qualifying homeowners. Renters may be eligible.

Energy conservation measures taken may include but are not limited to heating system repair or replacement, insulation, caulking, hot water jacket, water heater repairs or replacement, weather stripping, fluorescent lighting, carbon monoxide detecting, replacement of refrigerator etc.
