

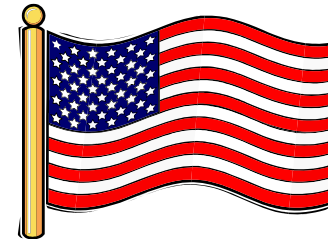

## MERCER COUNTY TRADE TRANSPORTATION

### Eligibility

TRADE Transportation provides transportation to seniors (age 60+) and people with disabilities who are residents of Mercer County. TRADE provides transportation Monday through Friday. Veterans who are age 60+ or veterans with disabilities may contact TRADE Transportation to request transportation to locations throughout Mercer County.

### Services

Demand-Response service is available with advance notice for a variety of trip purposes (i.e., medical, education, nutrition, shopping and recreation). Reservations must be made in advance (preferably 5-7 days), up to 14 days in advance, and all trips are reserved on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Appointment time slots are available from 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Subscription trips are available for customers who travel to destinations on a regular basis (i.e., dialysis, employment, shopping).

Customers should call TRADE between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon, at 609-530-1971, to request service.

### Services to Veterans—Trips to VA Hospitals in Lyons and East Orange

In cooperation with the New Jersey Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs (DMVA), TRADE Transportation will offer weekly transportation to veterans who need to travel to Veteran Administration (VA) hospitals in East Orange and Lyons, NJ.

TRADE Transportation will pick-up veterans in Trenton on Tuesday mornings for round-trip transportation to the VA hospital in Lyons, NJ. TRADE Transportation will also pick-up veterans in Trenton on Wednesday mornings for round-trip transportation to the East Orange VA hospital. There will be no charge to veterans for the service.

Veterans who are interested in this service can contact the DMVA, Division of Veterans Programs, at 609-292-5880 or 609-292-5881. The Division of Veterans Programs is located at 28 West State Street, Room 514, in Trenton. Reservations for the transportation to Lyons VA Hospital and East Orange VA Hospital need to be made in advance by calling 609-292-5880 or 609-292-5881. Information about the pick-up location (142 West State Street, Trenton) can also be obtained by calling 609-292-5880 or 609-292-5881.
