**MEDI-COOL PROGRAM**

With funding from the Mercer County Department of Human Services Office on Aging and United Way of Greater Mercer County (UWGMC), Catholic Charities, Trenton and Princeton Senior Resource Center have partnered with UWGMC to provide air conditioning units to needy senior residents of Mercer County between May 1 and May 31, 2007.

Catholic Charities, Trenton and Princeton Senior Resource Center (PSRC) will screen applicants for eligibility, provide a voucher for an air conditioner, and arrange for clients to pick up the unit at the United Way of Greater Mercer County office at 3131 Princeton Pike, building 4, Suite 113, Lawrenceville (exit 8A off I-95).

Eligibility criteria include: aged 60 and above, a disability or illness that restricts normal daily tasks or threatens one's ability to live independently or the risk of harm due to unfavorable environmental conditions or lack of social supports/resources; have income at or below 200% of Poverty line and assets under \$2,000.00. The following documents are required to determine eligibility: Proof of income, prescription from your primary care physician, proof of assets, and proof of residence.
