

## **PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

TAKE NOTICE that the County of Mercer and the New Jersey Turnpike Authority have filed a request with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program, proposing to transfer ownership of a portion of certain parklands from the County of Mercer to the New Jersey Turnpike Authority. The parkland to be transferred, located at Block 2732, Lots 3 and 4 in the Township of Hamilton, consists of approximately 1.454 acres of the parkland's total acreage of approximately 22 acres (the "Parkland").

The Parkland is needed in connection with the New Jersey Turnpike 6-9 Widening Program, which consists of approximately 35 miles of road widening and associated interchange improvements from the vicinity of Interchange 6, in Mansfield Township, Burlington County (Milepost 48) to Interchange 9 in East Brunswick Township, Middlesex County (Milepost 83).
