Andrew Dillman, requests the relaxation of the provisions of N.J.A.C. 4A:6-1.22 so as to permit him to donate 30 sick days to S.B.

:

S.B. is an approved recipient of donated leave and is currently participating in the program. To date, S.B. has received 179 sick days in total. The appointing authority indicates that Mr. Dillman possess 291 sick days in total, and has previously donated 30 sick days to S.B. It is noted that the appointing authority supports Mr. Dillman's request.

N.J.A.C. 4A:6-1.22(d) provides that a leave donor may not donate more than 30 such days to any one recipient and that a leave donor shall have remaining at least 20 days of accrued sick leave if donating sick leave and at least 12 days of accrued vacation leave if donating vacation leave. N.J.A.C. 4A:1-1.2(c) provides that a rule may be relaxed for good cause in a particular circumstance in order to effectuate the purposes of Title 11A, New Jersey Statutes.

CONCLUSION

Mr. Dillman, with support from the appointing authority, seeks approval to allow him to donate leave time beyond the 30 day limit set forth in N.J.A.C. 4A:6-1.22. Based on the particular circumstances presented, namely that S.B. is a current participant of the donated leave program, Mr. Dillman will have more than the minimum amount of sick leave upon donation and the appointing authority

supports Mr. Dillman's request, good cause exists to permit Mr. Dillman to donate 30 sick days to S.B.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ordered that this request be granted.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in a judicial forum.
