Notification and Response Policy State Fire Investigation / K-9 Unit

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:71-3.3(a)25, the State Fire Marshal / Fire Official shall investigate, or cause to be investigated, **EVERY reported fire or explosion** occurring within the jurisdiction of the State's Local Enforcing Agency (LEA) to determine the origin and cause of said fire or explosion. The investigation shall be initiated **IMMEDIATELY** upon the occurrence of such fire or explosion. As such, the Division of Fire Safety / State Fire Marshal's Office shall be notified at the time of the following incidents:

- Any fire or explosion in a *State LEA municipality*.
- Any fire or explosion within a state building or occurring on state property.
- Any incident which results in a serious injury or fatality to a firefighter. (FF <u>admitted</u> to a Hospital)
- Any fire or explosion in which the established investigative agency needs technical assistance.

In situations where the NJDFS is the LEA, as in those listed above, the State Fire Investigation Unit will be the primary agency conducting the fire origin and cause investigations. This Unit operates within the framework of a team concept, and the NJDFS may operate along with the NJ State Police Arson / Bomb Unit as deemed necessary.
