# You Need This Course

Effective April 2010, contractors, property owners and maintenance staff performing renovation, repair and painting projects that disturb lead-based paint in homes, child care facilities, and schools built before 1978 must be certified and must follow specific work practices to prevent lead contamination.

To become a Certified Renovator you must successfully complete an EPA - accredited renovator course.

#### This Lead Ready course is EPA approved.

Common renovation activities like sanding, cutting, and demolition can create hazardous lead dust and chips by disturbing lead-based paint, which can be harmful to children and adults. To protect against this risk, on April 22, 2008, EPA issued a rule requiring the use of lead-safe practices and other actions aimed at preventing lead poisoning. This rule took effect April 22, 2010.
