Notice of Action on Petition for Rulemaking

Local Government Ethics Law

N.J.A.C. 5:35

Petitioner: Mr. John Paff, Chairman, Open Government Advocacy Project, New Jersey Libertarian Party.

Take notice that on May 12, 2016, the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs received a petition for rulemaking from the above petitioner requesting a rule be promulgated defining which types of local government employees, contractors, and appointees are managerial executive employees of a local government agency and thus among the categories of persons that fall under the Local Government Ethics Law's definition of "local government officer" pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:9-22.3(g). A notice acknowledging receipt of the petition and summarizing its contents was published in the June 20, 2016 New Jersey Register at 48 N.J.R. 1319(b).

Take further notice that the above-referenced petition has been considered by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services. The Director has determined to refer the matter to Division of Local Government Services staff for further deliberation and recommendation on further action, pursuant to the time period set forth in N.J.A.C. 1:30-4.2(a)3.
