During the Environmental Record Review for the Endangered Species Act, the following project was determined to be within a Threatened and Endangered Species area for State Listed Species:

Project Location: **1 Greene Street, Apartment G3-G4, Jersey City, New Jersey (Hudson County); Block 65, Lot A2D.G3**

Project Description: **Rehabilitation of a single residential unit within a multifamily (5 or more units) structure in Jersey City.**

I am contacting you to conduct a review of the proposed project activities at this location to determine if any state listed species would be affected by any eligible activities. Your evaluation will enable us to complete the Environmental Review for the Activity/Project, which is Categorically Excluded Subject to Section 58.5 Pursuant to 24 CFR 58.35(a), and include any appropriate project specific conditions. Your response will be attached to the form as supporting documentation.

Review of the NJDEP ArcGIS screening tool threatened and endangered species layers for piping plover, red knot and federally listed bat species did not indicate occurrence of these species on the subject property; however, review of the centroid layer indicated the presence of state listed endangered species. Results of a Natural Heritage Program query indicate no state listed species on the subject property, but list five species of special concern and one state endangered species (Peregrine Falcon) in the immediate vicinity of the subject property.

I have attached maps of the project location and the property in relation to the Threatened and Endangered Species zones, as well as the Natural Heritage Program response to assist you in your review. I have also attached photographs of the subject property and vicinity.

There are no state mapped wetlands on or near the project and the need for wetlands permits is not anticipated.
