Project Description:

This proposed project involves the rehabilitation of a single residential unit (Apartment 1) within a multifamily structure located at 404 Monroe Street, in Hoboken, Hudson County, New Jersey (Block 57, Lot 22\_C0001). The multifamily structure, built in 2006 according to property tax records, comprise five units, one of which, Apartment 1, was damaged as a result of Superstorm Sandy. The scope of work includes repair and replacement of smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, building materials associated with a ground level recreation room, a wood window, toilets, bathroom vents/lights/heaters, ductwork, medicine cabinets, showerheads and other plumbing. The total estimated cost of repair is \$7,398.11. Because the unit is located in a multifamily structure, the structure, and hence the residential unit subject to the proposed action, will not be elevated. The damaged unit, Apartment 1, is reportedly the primary residence of Mr. Darren Macri. When completed, the proposed project will aid in the repair of a homeowner's primary residence damaged by Superstorm Sandy.
