Karyn,

As a follow-up to our conversation, the NJDEP reviewed the policy on identifying toxic sites within the 3,000-foot radius located across State lines. In cases where a surface water body separates State lines, out-of-State Toxic sites do not need to be identified for NJDEP compliance review. Surface water bodies are the physical expression of shallow ground water systems, and there is no reasonable expectation that out-of-State ground water contamination would cross water bodies to adversely affect New Jersey lands.

This information will be provided to all EAF contractors for reference.
