The existing building (an approximately 2,400 square foot (SF) pre-fabricated single story convenience store with an attached car wash) and fueling dispenser island will be demolished and replaced with a new building incorporating a 100-foot long car wash tunnel, retail area, second-story office area and three oil change/detailing bays with a basement service area. The fueling area would be downsized from the existing six fueling dispensers oriented in two (2) rows to a proposed single row of four (4) dispensers. This would decrease the number of fueling positions from twelve (12) to eight (8). The equipment would be modernized and the existing piping, fill ports, and containments related to the UST system would be replaced and brought to current code. The Project would implement the use of renewable energy (solar panels) on the canopy structure over the fuel dispenser islands, and the car wash would utilize an advanced water recycling system.
