Efforts to revive her were unsuccessful and P.C. was pronounced on this day at 1:45 p.m. During CP&P's investigation, it was discovered that P.C. was born at home, neither she nor her mother received medical attention, and both of her parents abused illegal substances. On 9/7/18, CP&P received autopsy results which noted the cause of P.C.'s death as "Complications following maternal gestational use of heroin and cocaine, and the manner of death as a homicide. CP&P concluded a Child Protection Service (CPS) investigation and substantiated both of P.C.'s parents (J.C., Sr., & J.C.) for neglect/child death, as well as substance abuse of caregiver threatens child. 's step-father (T.G.) indicated that she was tantruming and threw herself backwards down the steps. In addition, he reported that C.D. took a nap after this incident. C.D's medical doctor as well as a NJ forensic child abuse expert reported that C.D.'s injuries were not a result of a fall but physical abuse. On 7/18/18, T.G. admitted that he back handed C.D., which caused her to fall down the steps and sustain a fatal brain injury. CP&P completed a Child Protection Service (CPS) investigation and substantiated T.G. for physical abuse/child death and neglect/medical.
