⁽¹⁾ County of Incident is based on the municipality of incident. There are cases in each county in which abuse/neglect figures were not reported at the municipality level. In these instances, if one of the parents' municipalities was populated, it was substituted for the incident municipality. The mother's municipality was substituted first. Where this was missing, the father's municipality was referenced.

⁽²⁾ A report for an investigation can involve several children, or a child with several allegations or both. This chart counts children by separate incident, not allegations or investigations. If a child is the subject of several reports related to the same incident, that is counted once. But if that child is the subject of incidents on separate occasions - e.g. once in March and once in September - both of those incidents are included.

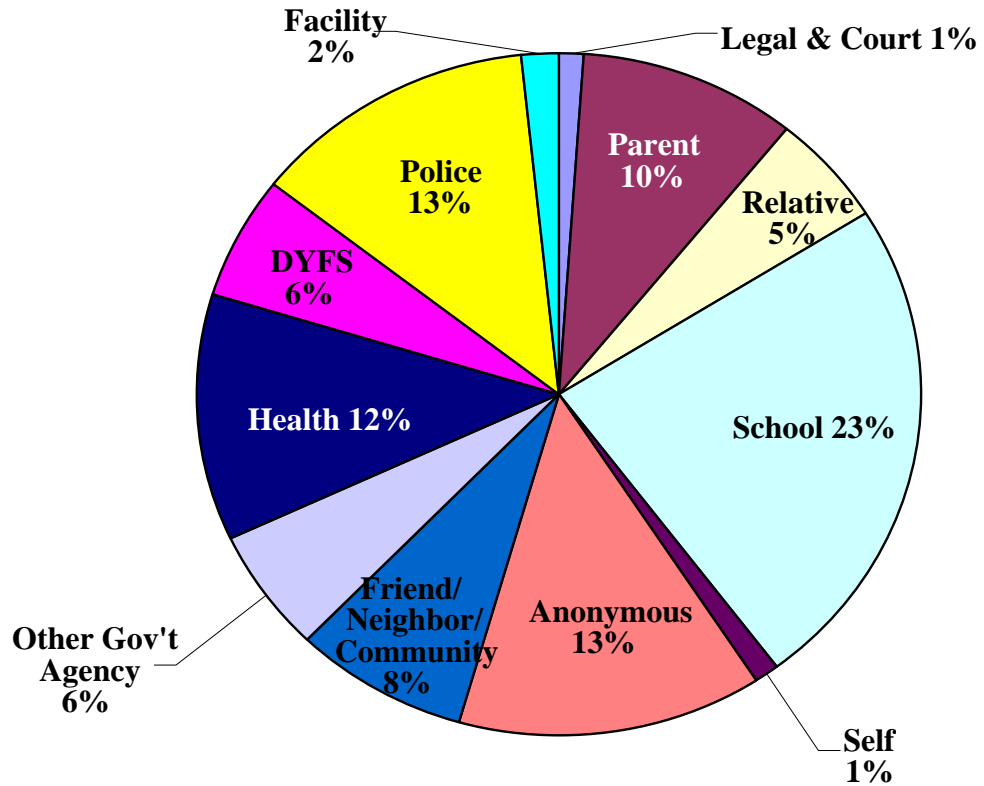

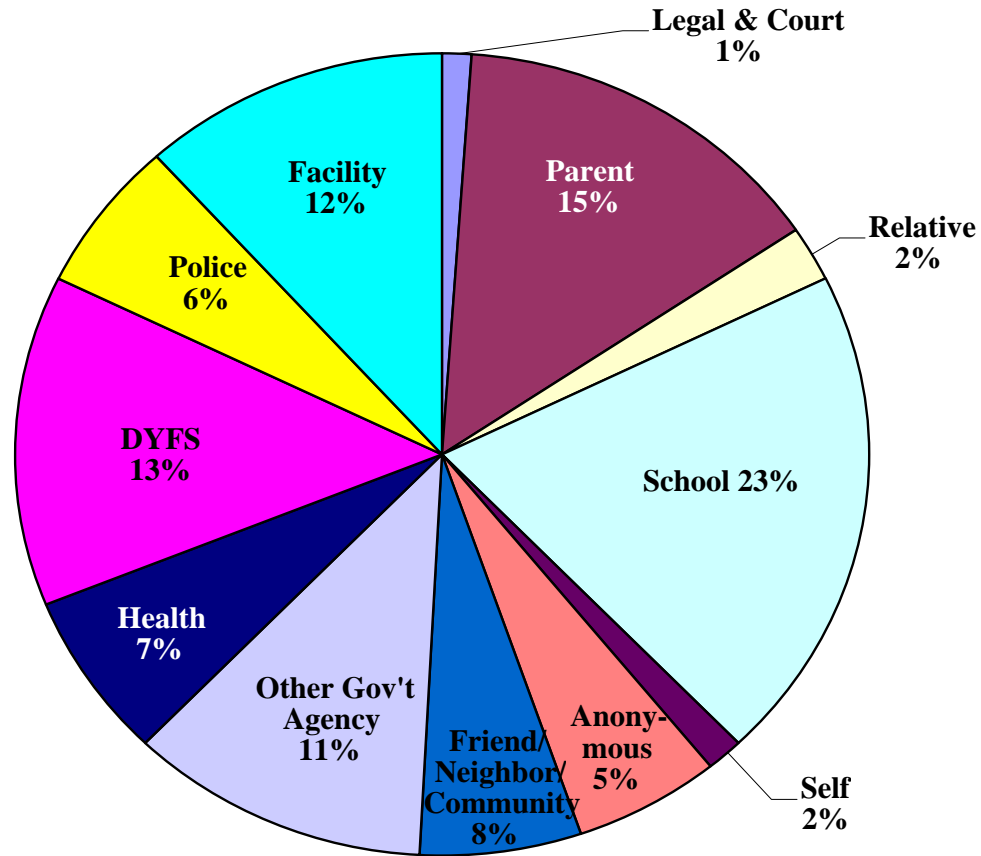
