This notice is to inform potential Bidder's that the available vouchers through the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (DCA) described in the New Jersey Department of Children and Families (DCF) Request for Proposals for Keeping Families Together (Pilot Program in Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland and/or Salem County) will be *twenty-five (25) 15-year Section 8 Project-Based Vouchers*. The awardee for this program is expected to have a concrete plan to access 25 affordable housing units in their proposed county (ies) for a 15 year period.
