The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Mercer County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated February 8, 2017. This request proposes County Plan inclusion to accept waste type 27I (materials consisting of incinerator ash or ash containing waste) as an additional waste at the Mercer County Transfer Station located at 1609 North Olden Avenue, Ewing Township, Mercer County, Block 13, lots 10 and 17. This additional waste type would not include any change in the total tonnage the facility is currently permitted to accept and further would not result in any changes to the facility's operations or hours of operation.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11 (b) 5, the inclusion of an existing facility to accept waste type 27I as an additional waste, can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, this administrative action is hereby approved pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
