The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Middlesex County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated October 23, 2018. Administrative Action 004-18 to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of additional recyclable materials accepted at the Fortune Metal Class D Recycling Center located at 900 Leesville Road (Block 891; Lots 212-239 and Block 892; Lots 45, 148-189) in the Township of Woodbridge. The proposed amendment requests the inclusion of lamps and mercury containing equipment. Acceptable lamps include mercury vapor, high-pressure sodium lights, incandescent, fluorescent, metal halide, compact fluorescent, LED, and mercury induction lightbulbs.

The County Plan inclusion of the additional recyclable materials will not result in any operational changes at the facility which is included in the County Plan to accept up to 100 tons per day of consumer electronics, non-PCB ballasts, and batteries.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, the modification of an existing recycling facility, including the acceptance of additional recyclable materials, can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of the additional recyclable materials accepted at the Fortune Metal Class D Recycling Center is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
