The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Middlesex County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated October 24, 2017. Administrative Action 003-17 to the County Plan proposes County plan inclusion of the name change and block and lot revision of the Tilcon New York Inc. Class B Recycling Center located at Block 76, Lots 1A and 1B; Block 80, Lots 1 and 2; and Block 90A, Lot 1A to Trap Rock Industries Class B Recycling Center located at Block 76, Lot 1.021 at the Foot of Crows Mill Road in the Township of Woodbridge.

The County Plan inclusion of the above noted name change and the block and lot revision of Trap Rock Industries Class B Recycling Center will not result in any operational changes at the facility which is included in the County Plan to accept up to 1,300 tons per day of concrete, reinforced concrete and asphalt.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, the inclusion of a change in name of an existing solid waste or recycling facility can be accomplished via an administrative action. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, a change in the block and lot designation of an existing solid waste or recycling facility can be accomplished through an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of a change in name and the block and lot revisions for the Trap Rock Industries Class B Recycling Center located at Block 76, Lot 1.021 is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
