The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Middlesex County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated December 31, 2018. Administrative Action 005-18 to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of the modified block and lot designation of the Clean Earth of Carteret Class B Recycling Center located at 24 Middlesex Avenue in the Borough of Carteret. Specifically, the block and lot designation included in the County Plan is proposed to be modified from Block 1, Lot 3.02 to Block 102, Lot 6.

The County Plan inclusion of the above noted block and lot revision of the Clean Earth of Carteret Class B Recycling Center will not result in any operational changes at the facility which is included in the County Plan to accept up to 4,000 tons per day of asphalt, concrete, brick, block, stone, and non-hazardous petroleum contaminated soil with a weekly averaging tonnage for all materials of 28,000 tons with a maximum amount on any given day of 4,700 tons.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, a change in the block and lot designation of an existing solid waste or recycling facility can be accomplished through an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of the modified block and lot designation for the Clean Earth of Carteret Class B Recycling Center located at Block 102, Lot 6 is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
