The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the New Jersey Sports & Exposition Authority (NJSEA) District Solid Waste Management Plan (District Plan) dated July 20, 2017. This amendment to the District Plan proposes District Plan inclusion of the revised processing hours of operation for the Allegro Sanitation Corporation Transfer Station/Materials Recovery Facility (TS/MRF) located at 278 Secaucus Road in the Town of Secaucus, Hudson County. Specifically, the revised hours of operation will be Monday through Saturday, 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for the processing of waste only.

In summary, the following hours of operation are included in the District Plan for the Allegro Sanitation Corporation TS/MRF:

- Acceptance of waste: Monday through Friday, 4:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. the following day (22 consecutive hours) and from 4:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m., Saturday
- Processing of waste: Monday through Saturday, 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, the inclusion of revised hours of operation can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the District Plan inclusion of the revised hours of operation at the Allegro Sanitation Corporation TS/MRF is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
