The Department of Environmental Protection's (Department) Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Program is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Somerset County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated May 3, 2013. The May 3, 2013 request for administrative action to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of asphalt roofing shingles, scrap tires, trees, tree stumps, and wood chips as acceptable materials for receipt, storage, and processing at the Yannuzzi & Sons, Inc. Class B Recycling Center, located on Block 142, Lot 23 at 152 US Highway 206 in the Township of Hillsborough.

The above noted modifications will not result in any other changes at the Yannuzzi & Sons, Inc. Class B Recycling Center, which was previously included in the County Plan to receive up to 2,000 tons per day (tpd) of concrete, asphalt, brick, and block and is currently permitted, through a DEP-issued Class B Recycling Center General Approval, to receive up to 1,500 tpd of concrete, asphalt, brick, and block.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, the inclusion of a modification of an existing facility including the acceptance, storage, and processing of additional waste types or recyclable materials can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of asphalt roofing shingles, scrap tires, trees, tree stumps, and wood chips as acceptable materials for receipt, storage, and processing at the Yannuzzi & Sons, Inc. Class B Recycling Center in the Township of Hillsborough is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

Please be advised that this approval shall not be construed as an expression of the Department's intent to issue a Class B Recycling Center General Approval Modification to the subject corporation for the above noted recycling activities.
