The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Somerset County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated June 21, 2018. The request proposes County Plan inclusion of a modified block and lot designation and the inclusion of additional parcels as part of the Bridgewater Resources, Inc. (BRI) Transfer Station/Materials Recovery Facility (TS/MRF) located in the Township of Bridgewater. Specifically, the block and lot designation included in the County Plan is proposed to be modified from Block 6103, Lot 1 to Block 340, Lot 1 and from Block 6101, Lot 3.2 to Block 305, Lot 3. In addition, the following parcel is proposed to be included in the County Plan: Block 306.01, Lot 1.

In summary, the following parcels are included in the County Plan for the BRI TS/MRF:

- Block 305, Lot 3
- Block 306.01, Lot 1
- Block 340, Lot 1

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, the inclusion of additional parcels of land to an existing solid waste facility can be accomplished via an administrative action. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, a change in the block and lot designation for an existing solid waste facility can be accomplished through an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of the modified block and lot designation and the inclusion of an additional parcel for the BRI TS/MRF is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
