The Stormwater Management Rules govern the development standards for State, municipal, and regional stormwater management requirements, plans, and ordinances. The rules are due to expire on February 2, 2010. The Department is holding this public information session to present the planned readoption strategy with certain amendments. The Department also wishes to hear from the public and interested parties about other areas of the rule where additional amendments might be considered for future rulemaking.
