

ACTIVITY: Grouse Habitat Improvement Project SITE IDs:

DESCRIPTION: This project involves clearcutting fifteen individual sites ranging in size from 1.0 to 2.3 acres (25.46 total) distributed in 3 separate locations. This will create early successional bird habitat necessary for cover and breeding range. The clearcuts area arranged in a checkerboard pattern adjacent to mature and young regenerating stands. This project will be administered by the New Jersey Division of Fish and Wildlife through the NJ Forest Service.
