

# **Atlantic Menhaden**

Brevoortia tyrannus

# **Description**:

- Silvery fish with dark bluish green back
- Pale yellow fins
- Very deep body with deeply forked tail
- Dark spot behind gill cover followed by a series of lighter spots

### Size:


Up to 14 inches

### Range:

Nova Scotia to Florida

#### **Facts:**

- Spawn in the ocean but young will spend first year in estuaries
- Schooling behavior and abundance make them the perfect food source for large populations of top predator fish like striped bass
- ❖ Împortant for filtering coastal waters due to large numbers of algae they consume
