Internship Project Description:

The Site Remediation Program is soliciting for unpaid volunteer student interns to work on various Site Remediation issues. Under the direction of a supervisor, interns will be exposed to the multi-disciplined nature of site remediation issues. Interns will have the opportunity to interact with municipal, state, and federal agency professionals thereby enhancing their communication and networking skills. Interns may also gain experience in research, analysis, policy development, and report writing. While interns will not be conducting legal research, they will learn about environmental investigation and clean-up, environmental restoration, and community outreach.

Estimated Project Duration and Suggested Weekly Work Schedule:

Internship Learning Objectives / Marketable Skills: Exposure to and understanding of environmental and community outreach issues. Communication, Research, Environmental Analysis, Policy Development, Report-writing skills.

Description of DEP Program Area/Work Unit Offering the Internship:

The Site Remediation Program (SRP) is responsible for evaluating, remediating, and overseeing the reuse and redevelopment of contaminated properties in New Jersey. In support of the Site Remediation Program, the Office of Community Relations strives to provide effective two-way outreach and communication with the public including federal, state and local officials, and concerned residents relative to contaminated sites and related remediation issues. The OCR staff welcomes calls from citizens for information on contaminated sites in their neighborhoods. The OCR staff is assigned to specific cases within the program to provide a direct line of communication through which to get information about a site or discuss concerns regarding the remediation process.
