Examples of Work:

- Alert visitors to regulations within a park and provide information.
- Assist with trash pickup and cleaning of staff areas.
- Interact with visitors outdoors for long periods of the day.
- Report emergencies.
- Perform visual inspections of parks facilities and grounds.

Note: Seasonal employees are assigned varied shifts that may go into the evening hours and may be assigned non-consecutive days off, such as a Monday and Wednesday. Seasonal employees are required to work weekends and holidays.

Seasonal Visitor Services positions are required to work outdoors in all types of weather conditions, often at a beach or in wooded areas of a park. Seasonal Visitor Service employees may come in contact with insects and wildlife.

Seasonal Visitor Services employees are required to purchase some uniform components (for example: khaki or spruce green pants and white collared shirt). It is recommended that you discuss uniforms during an interview.

Requirements: Ability to learn and apply rules, regulations, policies and procedures. Ability to learn and perform radio procedures. Ability to read, write, speak, understand and communicate English sufficiently to perform the duties of the position. Minimum age 16.

License: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in the United States only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
