**Program Description:** The Bureau of NJPDES Stormwater Permitting and Water Quality Management is a part of the Division of Watershed Protection and Restoration. It is responsible for regulating stormwater discharges of pollutants to surface water and ground water from municipal and industrial sources and advancing Water Quality Management through the coordination of planning and permitting activities.

**Project Description**: Under close supervision of a supervisory official in an environmental services program, learns to conduct routine surveys, studies, inspections, and/or investigations relating to the improvement and/or monitoring of environmental conditions, and/or the enforcement of environmental laws/regulations; does other related duties.

## **Specific to the Position:**

- Assist in the development, issuance, and management of New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) individual and general discharge permits for industrial, municipal, and commercial facilities.
- Assist in compiling and reviewing effluent and water quality data.
- Assist in the review of technical reports.
- Assist in the development of permit limits and/or BMPs, monitoring requirements, and other conditions to protect water quality.
- Assist in the development of guidance and other technical documents.
- Assist with GIS data creation, review, and analysis.
- Assist in the organization and updating of electronic file databases.

**Required Area of Study**: Seeking Individuals enrolled at an accredited university / college studying physical sciences, environmental sciences/studies, chemical sciences, biological sciences, environmental planning, physical geography or in civil engineering, sanitary engineering, chemical engineering, environmental engineering, mechanical engineering, agricultural engineering, mining engineering, industrial engineering, or bio-resource engineering.

**Preferred Skills:** Familiarity with software such as ArcPro, ArcMap, ArcGIS Online, Adobe, Python, or MS Access is preferred.

**License:** Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
