Do You Let Boat Owners Do Maintenance Work?

• Make sure that they do not contaminate the Marina

• Make sure they dispose of their waste properly

• YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE!!!

Generators of Hazardous Waste

- Large Quantity Generators
- Small Quantity Generators
- Conditionally Exempt Generators

• >2,200-lbs/month

• >220<2,200lbs/month

- <220-lbs/month
- The above amounts do not include used oil

SMALL QUANTITY GENERATOR

- 1. DETERMINE IF WASTE IS HAZARDOUS
- 2. CONTAINER MANAGEMENT REGS.
- 3. CONDENSED CONTINGENCY PLAN
- 4. PREPAREDNESS & PREVENTION
- 5. MUST USE HAZARDOUS WASTE MANIFEST
- 6. CLASS "C" DISPOSAL FACILITY (TSDF)

Satellite Containers for Hazardous Waste

- 1. 55-GALLONS LIMIT PER WASTE STREAM
- 2. MUST BE IDENTIFIED AS A SATELLITE AREA
- 3. CONTAINERS MUST BE IN GOOD CONDITION
- 4. CONTAINERS MUST NOT BE LEAKING
- 5. CONTAINERS MUST BE LABELED

HAZARDOUS

FEDERAL LAW PROHIBITS IMPROPER DISPOSAL

Satellite Containers for Hazardous Waste

- 6. CONTAINERS MUST BE CLOSED WHEN NOT IN USE
- 7. CONTAINERS MUST BE DATED WHEN FULL
- 8. WHEN FILLED, MOVE TO ACCUMULATION AREA WITHIN 3 DAYS

ACCUMULATION CONTAINER MANAGEMENT

- WASTE KEPT IN A SUITABLE CONTAINER
- CONTAINER MARKED "HAZARDOUS WASTE"
- CONTAINER DATED PROPERLY
- MANAGED PROPERLY
- CONTAINER SHIPPED TO TSDF WITH IN 180/270 DAYS.

CONTAINER MANAGEMENT REQUIREMENTS

- AISLE SPACE
- VISIBLE LABELS
- CONTAINERS IN GOOD CONDITION
- CLOSED WHEN NOT IN USE
- COMPATIBLE WITH WASTE
- DOCUMENTED INSPECTIONS AS REQUIRED
- LOCATION OF ACCUMULATION AREA IDENTIFIED

SQG CONTINGENCY PLAN

- 1. HAVE A PERSON ONSITE WHO IS IN CHARGE
- 2. POST THE FOLLOWING NEXT TO TELEPHONE
 - A. NAME & PHONE NUMBER OF EMERGENCY COORDINATOR
 - **B. LOCATION OF EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT**
 - C. PHONE NUMBERS OF FIRE DEPARTMENT

SQG CONTINGENCY PLAN

- 3. TRAIN ALL PERSONNEL IN HANDLING HAZARDOUS WASTE & EMERGENCY PROCEEDURES(ON THE JOB OR CLASSROOM)
- 4. EMERGENCY COORDINATOR MUST BE ABLE TO RESPOND TO ALL EMERGENCIES
- 5. DOCUMENTATION

SQG PREPAREDNESS & PREVENTION

- 1. MAINTAIN FACILITY TO MINIMIZE UNPLANNED RELEASE
- 2. HAVE INTERNAL ALARM, TELEPHONE, & EMERGNCY EQUIPMENT
- 3. REGULARILY TEST & MAINTAIN EQUIPMENT
- 4. AISLE SPACE IN HAZARDOUS WASTE AREA
- 5.ARRANGEMENTS WITH THE LOCAL POLICE DEPARTMENT, FIRE DEPARTMENT, & EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAMS

SQG MANIFESTS

- 1. FILL OUT MANIFESTS PROPERLY & COMPLETELY
- 2. SIGN & DATE MANIFEST(GENERATOR & TRANSPORTER)
- 3. GIVE TRANSPORTERS PROPER COPIES
- 4. MAIL COPIES TO ALL STATES INVOLVED
- 5. SAVE RETURN COPY FROM TSDF FOR 3 YEARS
- 6. FILED EXCEPTION REPORT IN YOU DO NOT RECEIVE A COPY FROM THE TSDF

LAND BAN CERTIFICATION FORMS

- ONE COPY SENT WITH MANIFEST, OR AT LEAST KEPT ON FILE AT TSDF
- ONE COPY, ATTACHED TO GENERATOR COPY OF MANIFEST, RETAINED FOR 3 YEARS

HAZARDOUS WASTE REQUIREMENTS UNDER RCRA

- HAVE EPA ID. NUMBER Jack Hoyt (212) 637-4106
- USE A HAZARDOUS WASTE MANIFEST.
- CONTAINER MANAGEMENT. DOCUMENT INSPECTIONS
- CONTINGENCY PLAN....EMERGENCY PROCEEDURES.
 DOCUMENT
- DEVELOP & IMPLEMENT A TRAINING PROGRAM DOCUMENT
- COMPLY WITH PREPAREDNESS AND PREVENTION REQUIREMENTS. DOCUMENT

CONDITIONALLY EXEMPT S Q G

- 1. DETERMINE IF WASTE IS HAZARDOUS
- 2. MANAGE WASTE PROPERLY WHILE ON SITE
 - A. CONTAINER MANAGEMENT
 - **B. VERY LITTLE MONITORING**
- 3. DISPOSE OF WASTE PROPERLY
 - A.. MINIMUM DISPOSAL CLASS "D" MUNICIPAL LANDFILL
 - B. NO TRACKING OF WASTE (BOL)
- 4. DOCUMENTATION OF WASTE GENERATED

Parts Cleaning Stations

Solvents

Petroleum Products

Liquid Detergents

- Hazardous Waste (manifest if lqg or sqg)
- Hazardous/Non-Hazardous
- Non-Hazardous (Bill of Lading)

Used Oil

- Store Properly (Keep Closed)
- Label Container/Tank (Used Oil)
- Use "Used Oil Transporter"
- Bill of Lading
- NO SPILLS Around Container/Tank
- Drain Oil Filters



Antifreeze

• Environmentally Safe

 Dispose of as per Directions on Label

- Regular antifreeze
- Do NOT dispose of via septic or sewer
- Recycle & Reuse On Site
- Handle as Used Oil &Dispose of Through a Used Oil Hauler

Waste gasoline

- Store Separately From Used Oil
- Keep Container Closed & Labeled
- Contact Used Oil Hauler For Disposal
- Bill Of Lading: Specify "for energy recovery"

Freon

• Recycle & reuse on site Using proper machine & Licensed Tech.

• Contract With licensed Tech Remove Freon Before Disposing of Equipment.

Batteries (New & Used)

- Store inside.
- Keep caps on.
- NO SPILLS!
- Exchange used for new on a regular bases.
- Can be considered a hazardous waste if not recycled.
- Keep documentation of disposal



Painting STORE PAINT AND MATERIALS INSIDE NO SPILLS

- Brush & Roller
- Paint chips
- Waste cleaning solvents
- Waste Solvent paints
- Waste latex paints

- Let dry & discard as Solid Waste
- Solid/Hazardous Waste (metals in paints)
- Hazardous Waste

- Hazardous Waste or Recycle
- Solid Waste or Recycle



Power Washing

Do not contaminate ground or water with solids washed from boat.

Use a bermed filter cloth for a containment area.
