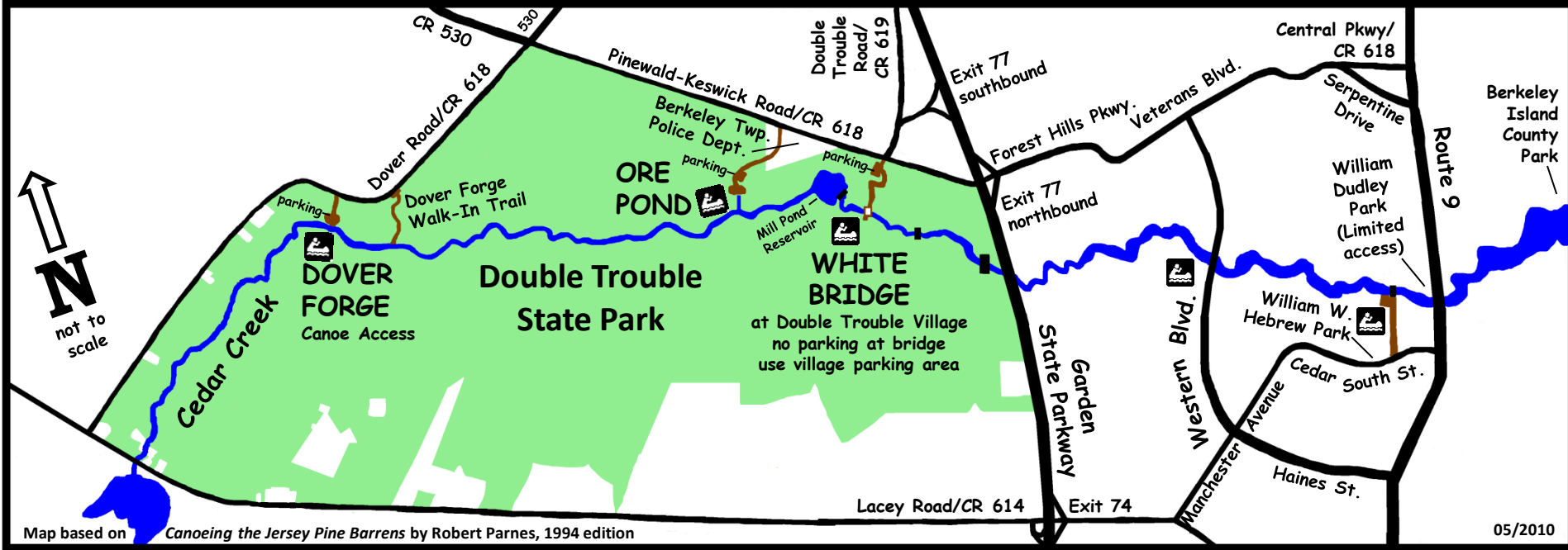




Double Trouble State Park

There are three canoe and kayak access locations in Double Trouble State Park: at Dover Forge off Dover Road; at Ore Pond off Pinewald-Keswick Road; and at the White Bridge in Double Trouble Village. Paddlers are permitted to carefully drive through the village to drop off or pick up their canoe or kayak. There is no parking at the White Bridge. Vehicles are not permitted at the Mill Pond Reservoir or around the cranberry bogs. Tubing, rafting and swimming are prohibited at Double Trouble State Park. Canoes and kayaks are not available for rent at the state park.
