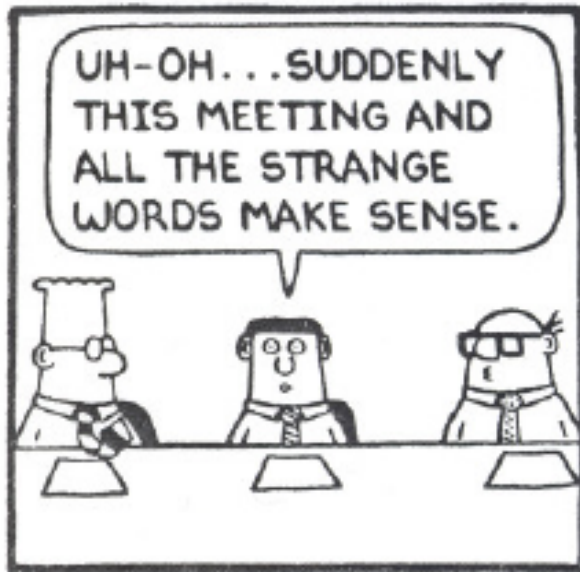

### Site Remediation Program

May 7, 2012 is the day on which the phase-in period for implementing the [Site Remediation Reform Act, N.J.S.A. 58:10C-1 et seq.](#) (SRRRA), and related amendments to the [Brownfield and Contaminated Sites Act](#) (Brownfield Act), the [Spill Compensation and Control Act](#), and the [Industrial Site Recovery Act](#) ended.

As of May 7, 2012, with limited exceptions, all remediations in the state of New Jersey, without regard to when remediation was initiated, are to proceed under the supervision of a Licensed Site Remediation Professional (LSRP), without New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) approval following the nine requirements set forth at [N.J.S.A. 58:10B-1.3b\(1\) through \(9\)](#).

The goal is to increase the pace of remediation, thus helping to decrease the threat of contamination to public health and safety and of the environment, and to quickly return underutilized properties to productive use.

Key provisions of SRRRA and related amendments:

- Establishes the [Site Remediation Professional Licensing Board](#) (Board) and the LSRP program. The Board issues licenses to qualified individuals (LSRPs), who conduct the remediation of sites in New Jersey. Every LSRP is bound by a strict [code of ethics](#), violation of which could result in the assessment of penalties and the suspension or revocation of the LSRP's license.
- Sets forth the [affirmative obligation](#) of every person responsible for conducting remediation to remediate any

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● **Site Remediation**

The Site Remediation Program is responsible for the remediation of contaminated sites in New Jersey. The Program includes publicly funded and privately funded sites, Superfund sites, brownfields, and other more specific bureaus that focus on underground storage tanks (UST) and the Industrial Site Recovery Act (ISRA). However, The Program's role is not limited to the oversight and cleanup of sites with confirmed contamination. The Program also handles cases where contamination is suspected, but not yet confirmed. In addition, the Program also has substantial non-remedial responsibilities such as the Initial Notice Section, which is responsible for UST regulated facilities, ISRA and UST application, UST certifications and other administrative responsibilities.

Please be advised that any report posted on Data Miner should not be used as a sole source of information when conducting a due diligence investigation into whether or not a particular site is contaminated. The fact that a site of interest is not listed in a report does not constitute a due diligence search on behalf of a prospective purchaser or interested person.

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● **Licensed Site Remedial Professional Information**

On May 7, 2009, Governor Jon Corzine signed the Site Remediation Reform Act N.J.S.A. 58:10C - 1 ("SRRA") into law. One of the provisions of the law establishes a program for the licensing of Licensed Site Remediation Professionals ("LSRPs") who will have responsibility for the oversight of environmental investigations and cleanups.

SRRA provides that until a Licensed Site Remediation Professional Board is established, NJDEP may issue temporary licenses to LSRPs upon a determination by NJDEP that an applicant for a temporary license meets all of the criteria listed in SRRA at N.J.S.A. 58:10C-13 such as the requisite education and experience concerning the remediation of contaminated sites.

This DataMiner sub-category includes a list of individuals to whom NJDEP has issued temporary LSRP licenses. These individuals on the list have met the criteria for obtaining a temporary LSRP license and have paid the annual fee.

- [Financial Obligation Summary Report](#)  
This report enables the requestor to determine if there are any outstanding oversight cost bills for a given site that have not been paid. The requestor can also determine if oversight costs have been charged to the site but have not yet been included in a bill. The name of the party the Department has on record as responsible for paying the oversight bill can be found here as well as information about financial assurance for the site and oversight payment history. Among other reasons, this report can be used to assure that all oversight costs have been paid before certifying requests to proceed with remediation without the Department's oversight.
- [License Site Professional Comprehensive Report](#)  
This report enables the user to lookup a Licensed Site Remedial Professional (LSRP); view all the documents received by SRP from the selected LSRP; and view all the projects assigned to the LSRP. This comprehensive report includes information on case status, case type, SRP review status and other administrative data. NOTE: The Active designation next the licensee's name indicates the status of the License Site Remediation Professional (LSRP) License. Active = Yes means that the person has filed for a Temporary LSRP License, the application was approved. Active = No means that the person has filed for a Temporary LSRP License, the application was approved, however, the licensee has either requested to have their Temporary LSRP license to be withdrawn or the DEP has been notified that the licensee is deceased.

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- **Site Search Reports**

This category is designed to enable the requestor to find one specific site or Program Interest (PI) name via information entered into a "prompt field" by the requestor. If the requestor knows the site Name or PI Name or part of the PI Name; the PI Address or part of the PI Address; or the PI Number, a search can be performed. The search will retrieve a list of all active SRWM sites, which contain the data that was entered into the "prompt field". The resulting lists of active SRWM sites include contaminated sites as well as sites that only require DEP permits and / or other administrative information. Thus, it is important to realize that the discovered sites may or may not be contaminated. Once a final selection is made, the site of interest can be selected and reviewed. Further information can be obtained by linking to the Site Detail Report.

The Site Detail Report further breaks down the site selection by cases; one site may include several cases. Cases are usually cleanups that are being conducted by different bureaus at the same time or at varying times in the site's history. The progress of a case is often tracked by the documents that are being reviewed; therefore, an active site can include closed cases and closed documents.

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### Case Tracking Reports

This category is designed to enable the requestor to find upcoming and past due tasks associated with a case that are considered by the Department to be incomplete. These reports are intended to assist responsible entities and LSRPs in evaluating due dates for required submittals, and whether the Department is in receipt of these submittals. If the requestor knows the PI Number, the name of the organization conducting the remediation or License Site Professional (LSRP) License Number, a search can be performed. The search will retrieve a list of cases for which past due tasks are considered by the Department to be incomplete, as well as upcoming due tasks, based on the data entered in the Department's data management system.

These reports do not capture every regulatory or mandatory timeframe due date established in Site Remediation rules (i.e., ARRCs, UST, ISRA or Technical Requirements). In some instances, the Department may only become aware of a due date after the due date has passed and for which these timeframes apply. Also, the user should be aware that new information regarding cases is provided to the Department daily, and should therefore check these reports frequently for updates.

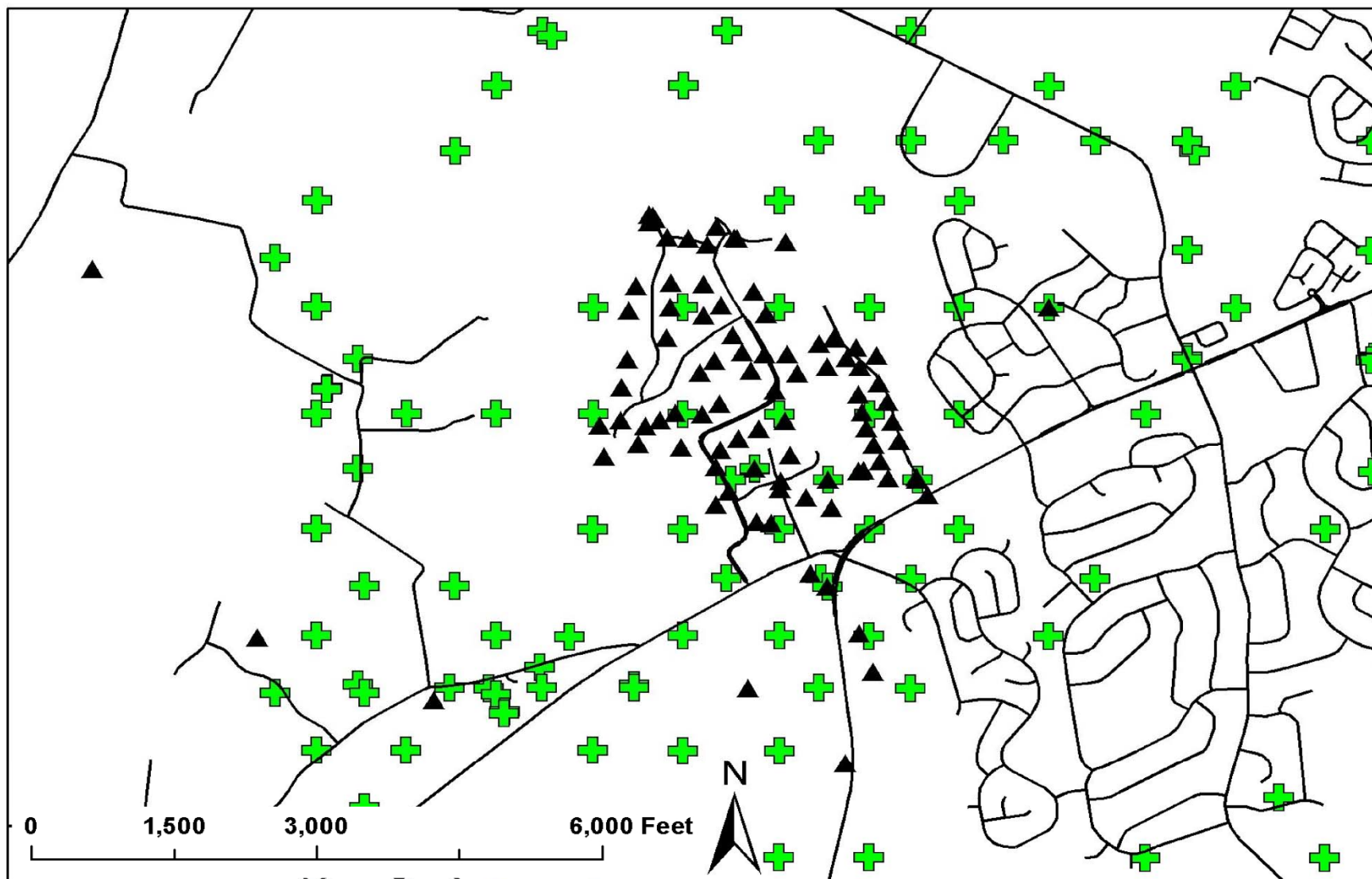

 Consultant Locations

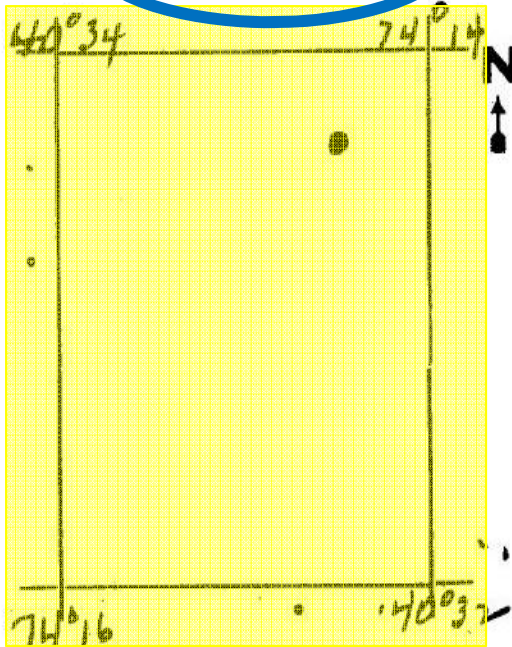






### Location of Well

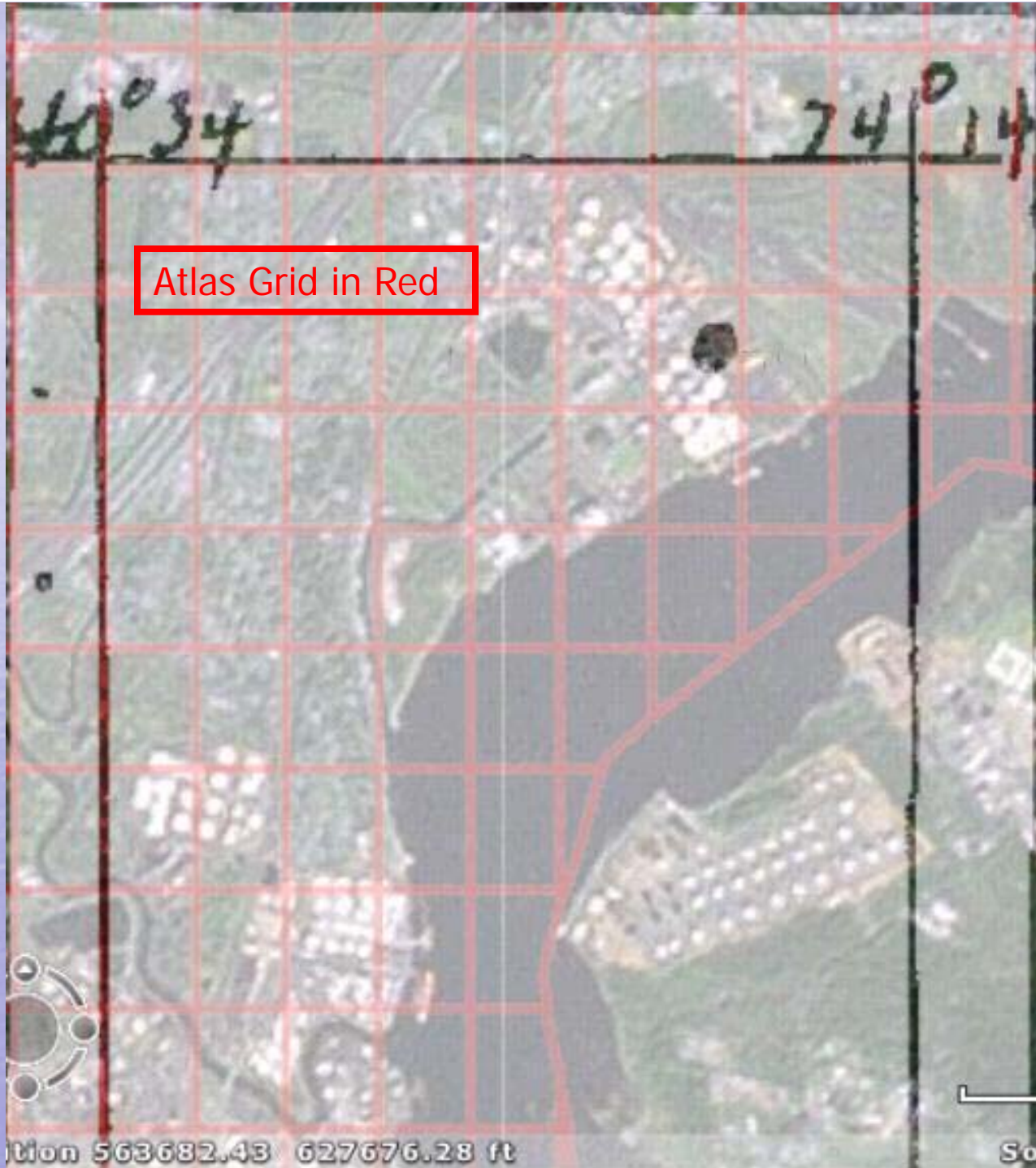

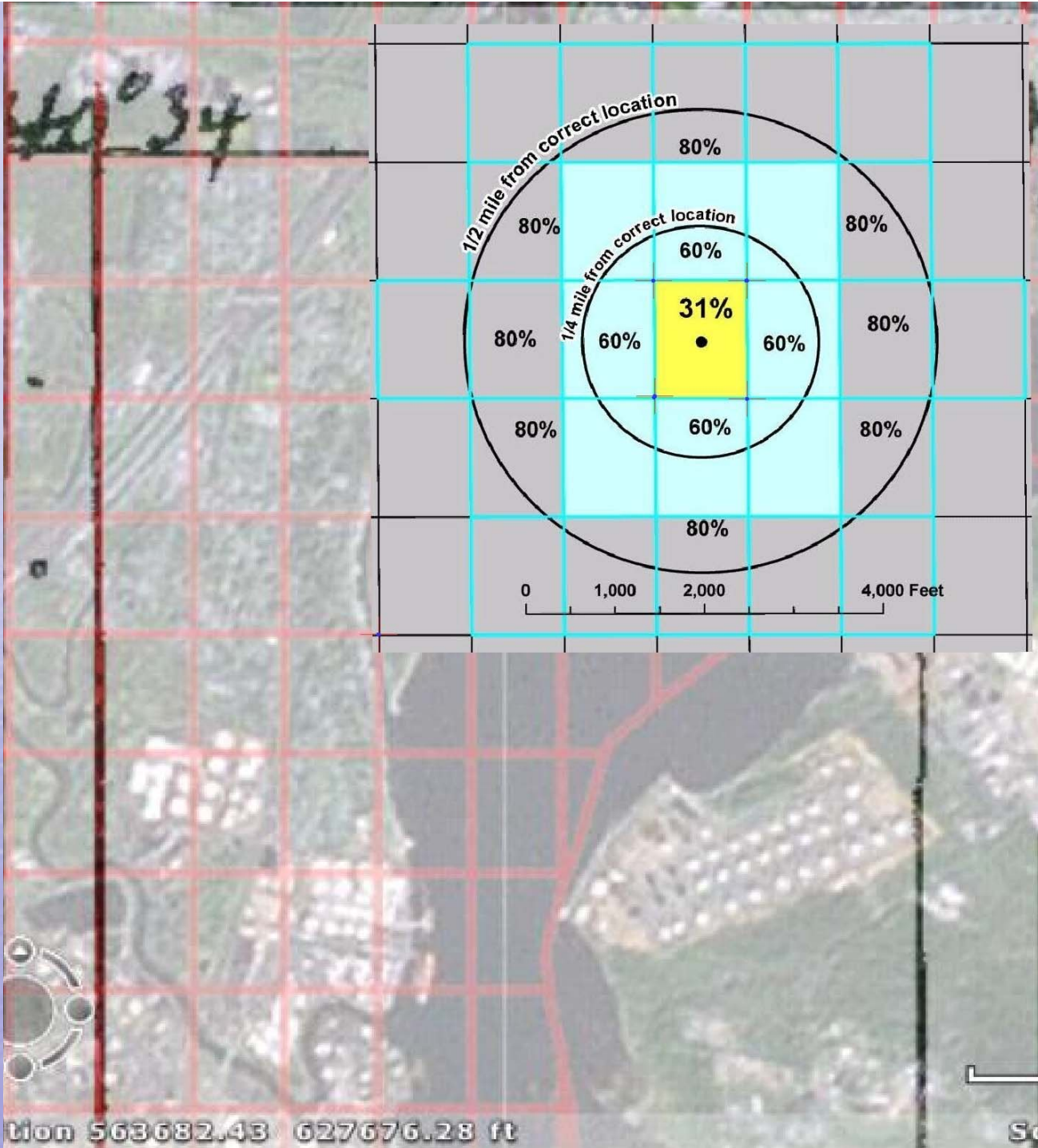

## Fee Issues - Who is Subject?

- An Annual Remediation Fee is required for every LSRP case (that is not under direct oversight)
- Child Care and UHOT cases are exempt from the annual fee requirement.
  - Child Care RAO - Billed for oversight costs
  - Unregulated Heating Oil Tank NFA - \$400





## Fee Issues

- Annual Remediation Fees are based on the number of areas of concern and environmental media impacted
- 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Remediation Fee is due based on when the case enters the LSRP program
- All fees and oversight costs must be paid prior to the issuance of a Response Action Outcome

## Annual Remediation Fee Due Dates

- Cases in the LSRP program before May 7, 2012 must pay the 1<sup>st</sup> annual remediation fee 270 days from the triggering date (i.e., date of discharge, ISRA trigger or closure of a regulated UST)
- Subsequent Annual Fees will be invoiced and are due every 365 days







# Annual Remediation Fee Due Dates

- Cases that were converted to LSRP cases on May 7, 2012 were required to pay the 1<sup>st</sup> annual remediation fee on June 20, 2012
- 1<sup>st</sup> annual remediation fees are prorated based on when the second annual remediation fee is due

## Annual Remediation Fee Due Dates

- Cases that enter the LSRP program after May 7, 2012 must pay the 1st annual remediation fee 45 days after they are required to hire an LSRP
- Subsequent Annual Fees will be invoiced and are due every 365 days





# Fee Issues

- Annual Remediation Fee for regulated UST cases is \$450 when case is a clean closure or remediation completed before the next annual fee is due
- The fee must be paid prior to the due date
- Submittals received late (after the due date) increases the Annual Remediation Fee to \$900





## Individual Document Review Fees

- The Biennial Certification fee is \$375 unless the remediating party has a remedial action permit that covers the biennial certification
- Discharge to Ground Water Proposal (PBR) is \$350
- On-scene coordinator discharge authorization (for discharges to surface water) for an unregulated heating oil tank remediation is \$400





## Important Fee Facts – Gov. Entities

- Non-Spill Act responsible government entities (or non-profits) are only required to pay annual remediation fees during years they are performing remediation
- The fee is due within 45 days after starting remediation
